



Skylab 4, manned mission 3

November 16, 1973 - 8 February 1974

Skylab 4 was the last manned mission to the Skylab station, the first U.S. orbital space station. The mission was launched on a Saturn 1B rocket (SA-208) and carried a three-person crew to the station. Gerald P. Carr - Commander, William R. Pogue - Pilot, Edward G. Gibson - Science Pilot.

The Skylab 4 mission astronauts performed scientific experiments which included medical activities, solar observations, observation of the Comet Kohoutek, Earth resources and other experiments. The mission lasted 84 days, 1 hour and 16 minutes.
